


# The most important 20 minutes of your day... Reading and enjoying books

- Duration 1 hour each fortnight
- Music in Year 3 focuses on learning more complex rhythms and reading notes on the music staff. Students learn to combine these skills to read simple music notation. Simple tunes are played on glockenspiels. Students also learn to sing a range of music from different cultures and genres (including rounds). Movement and dance is an integral part of the music program.
- Dance teaches students to perform a variety of dances, from a selection of genres, that involve a range of elements including space, time, dynamics and relationships.
